Dear Worth Park District Residents and Families:

The Worth Park District is happy to announce the reopening of additional programs, services and amenities under Phase 4 of the *Restore Illinois Plan*. During Phase 4, the Park District will continue to monitor the status of COVID-19 and follow the advice and guidance of the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO), the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) and the Park District Risk Management Agency (PDRMA). Our focus will remain in doing the right and safe thing for all Park District residents and families

In Phase 4, the Park District can resume all its operations, parks, amenities, etc. with the group gathering requirement of **50 people or less**. This will be monitored and adhered to as we continue to receive guidance through this phase. So, what does this all mean?

- **All Park District playgrounds are open**
- **Basketball Courts are open**
- **Tennis Courts, soccer fields, skate park and ball diamonds are open**
- **Summer Day Camp starts July 1**
- **In person youth, adult, senior and fitness programs can resume.**
- **Terrace Centre is open now with regular business hours.**
- **Facility and shelter rentals can be held**

We are excited to be back!

As we proceed through Phase 4, the Park District wants to remind all visitors to its parks and facilities, they should adhere to the recommended guidelines during their visit:

- Do not use a park site or equipment if you or anyone from your household is experiencing symptoms of COVID-19
- Wash your hands often or use hand sanitizer. You should bring your own hand sanitizer.
- Sanitize surfaces such as picnic tables and park benches before and after use.
- Maintain social distancing of 6 feet from individuals outside of your household.
- Group sizes should be limited to 50 people
- 30 feet of distancing should be maintained between groups of 50.
- Wear a face covering when social distancing is not possible
