As you are aware, on Friday, March 20, 2020, Governor Pritzker issued a new **Executive Order 2020-10** requiring all Illinoisans to stay at home (with limited exceptions) from Saturday, March 21, at 5 p.m. through April 7, 2020.

The order specifically states individuals may leave their residences to engage in outdoor activity such as walking, hiking, running or biking and may go to public parks and open outdoor recreation areas *if* they comply with the Social Distancing Requirements defined in the order - **but playgrounds must close.**

So as per this Order, all Park District playgrounds are closed to public use until further notice.

When important information is known, we will continue to update this website accordingly. Please note that the Park District website www.worthparkdistrict.org will be the only website in which any information regarding COVID-19, closings, cancellations, etc. will be communicated.
